### Erdinger Weissbier

Crystal-clear with an inviting frothy head, this lively wheat beer specialty features fruity-fresh aromas. 16.9 oz. 13 IBU, 5.3 % ABV

### Bell's Two Hearted IPA

Finished in the bottle like a fine wine, this traditional Bavarian wheat beer from Germany's oldest brewery (since 1040) combines wheat and yeast aromas with mild bitter hops. The invigorating carbon dioxide ensures its typical liveliness. 16.9 oz, 14 IBU, 5.1 % ABV

### Bitburger Radler

**\$ 7.50**

Back in 1922 a Bavarian Inn keeper got worried about his beer supply when numerous thirsty bicyclists poured into his pub after a nearby bicycle race. Without further ado he decided to mix his beer with sparkling lemonade. The bicyclists ("Radler" in German) loved it and a new drink was born. 16.9 oz, 12 IBU, 2.5 % ABV

### Dr. Loosen Dry Riesling

**\$ 9.50**

A very fruity dry white with some earthy undertones and noticeable acidity. Grown in the Mosel region of Germany.

### Leese-Fitch Chardonnay

**\$ 9.50**

A typical dry Chardonnay from the Sonoma region in California. Aromas of creamy baked apples, hints of citrus and lingering toasty oak finish.

### Crane Lake White Zinfandel

**\$ 7.00**

Light pink, medium sweet wine with floral and tropical aromas. Made with grapes from the Napa and Sonoma regions in California

### Hard Seltzer

**White Claw, various flavors, 16.9 oz**

### La Playa Merlot

**\$ 9.50**

A dry red grown in the Colchagua Valley of Chile. Aromas of plums, blackberries and a hint of toasted oak with a good balance and a soft finish.
